Restricted access per user can be implemented at laboratory level for security reasons.

UNB: The United National Breweries (UNB) approached QBCon to add a new monthly management report system to Lab-i, a laboratory Information Management System (LIMS).

Management will draw a monthly report on the averages of tests done according to supplier, material and sample type. Once the system is operational, management will determine which raw materials or ingredients from which suppliers are of higher quality.
